

Pursuant to Article 17 of the Law on the Council of Ministers of BiH (Official Gazette of BiH, 30/03, 42/03, 81/06, 76/07, 81/07, 94/07, 24/08) and Article 7 (5) of the Decision on the system of coordination in the process of European integration in BiH (Official Gazette of BiH, 72/16), at the 75th session held on 28 September 2016, at the proposal of the Directorate for European Integration, the Council of Ministers of BiH adopted the following

DECISION
ON ESTABLISHMENT OF THE COMMISSION FOR EUROPEAN INTEGRATION

Article 1
(Subject matter and objective)

- 1) This Decision establishes the Commission for European Integration (hereinafter: the Commission) which operates within the system of vertical coordination of the European integration process in BiH.
- (2) The objective of the Commission establishment is to provide general, operational and methodological coordination of operation of competent institutions at all levels of government in BiH in order to achieve the highest level of comprehensiveness in the European integration process.

Article 2
(Composition of the Commission)

- (1) The Commission shall be comprised of permanent and complementary members in accordance with Article 7(1) and (2) of the Decision on the system of coordination in the process of European integration in BiH (Official Gazette of BiH, 72/16) (hereinafter: Decision on the coordination system). .
- (2) Permanent Commission members are:
 - a) Edin Dilberović, Directorate for European Integration, chair;
 - b) Adnan Tatar, Office of the FBiH Government for European Integration, deputy chair;
 - c) Radmila Dragišić, RS Government, deputy chair;
 - d) Lejla Mujkić, Sarajevo Canton Government, member;
 - e) Muhamed Softić, Central Bosnia Canton Government, member;
 - f) Senad Ovčina, Tuzla Canton Government, member;
 - g) Dženana Čolaković, Zenica-Doboj Canton Government, member;
 - h) Dijana Dedić, Una-Sana Canton Government, member;
 - i) Emir Sijerčić, Bosnian Podrinje Canton Government, member;
 - j) Vesna Hrsto, West Herzegovina Canton Government, member;
 - k) Zoran Semren, Canton 10 Government, member;
 - l) Franc Kljajić, Posavina Canton Government, member;
 - m) Kristina Crnjac, Herzegovina-Neretva Canton Government, member;
 - n) Ilija Stojanović, BD BiH Government, member;
 - o) Sabina Konjhodžić, Directorate for European Integration, secretary.

- (3) The composition of complementary Commission members is laid down by Article 7(2) of the Decision on coordination system.

(4) Complementary members shall participate in the Commission's work upon invitation of the Commission chair, in accordance with the meeting agenda, based on prior approval of all permanent members.

Article 3
(Scope of work)

The Commission shall carry out tasks laid down in Article 6 (1) and (2) of the Decision on the coordination system, and:

- a) initiate preparation of regular meetings of joint bodies of the European Union and BiH (hereinafter: joint bodies) pursuant to the Decision 1/2015 of the Stabilisation and Association Council and Decision 1/2015 of the Stabilisation and Association Committee, through the standing delegations laid down in Article 11 of the Decision on the coordination system;
- b) monitor the implementation of conclusions and recommendations defined by joint bodies and guide all relevant participants of the process in their appropriate implementation and application;
- c) initiate and prepare documents, information and other materials for work of joint bodies in cooperation with standing delegations, in accordance with guidelines of the Directorate for European Integration.
- d) perform other tasks in the European integration process.

Article 4
(Method and organisation of work)

(1) The Commission shall adopt rules of procedure.

(2) Expert, administrative-technical and operational tasks for the purposes of the Commission shall be performed by the secretary of the Commission and the Directorate for European Integration.

Article 5
(Entry into force)

This Decision shall enter into force on the date of adoption and shall be published in the Official Gazette of BiH.
